THE CITY OF WATAUGA'S PARTNERSHIP WITH FRONTIER WASTE SOLUTIONS FOR SOLID WASTE SERVICES WILL BEGIN JULY 1, 2022.

PLEASE DO NOT SET FRONTIER TRASH CART OUT FOR SERVICE UNTIL: THE FIRST WEEK OF JULY (July 1st - 7th)

TRASH & RECYCLE SERVICE DETAILS

- * Frontier Waste will be providing automated trash & recycle collection services ONCE per week utilizing a Frontier Waste 95-gallon cart & a recycle 65-gallon cart (see back page for WEEKLY Bulk Collection)
- * Please place cart 4 feet from any objects (car, mailbox, tree) and 2 feet from the curb or edge of the street. (refer to attached diagram for proper cart placement)
- * At City's request, Frontier will only collect trash placed inside Frontier Trash Cart, except brush/bulky waste as described on back.
- * Please bag your trash to help eliminate wind blown debris in your community
- * **Please have carts set out at the curb, for service, by 6:45 a.m. on your service day.**

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS – Please do not dispose of the following in your trash cart: chemicals, corrosive liquids or materials, flammable liquids or materials, explosive liquids or materials, biomedical liquids or materials, or other toxic materials

*****SHARPS:** Please put needles used for insulin injections into a thick, hard plastic container to protect solid waste employees (ex: laundry detergent container or sharps container)

WASTE & RECYCLE COLLECTION SERVICE DAYS – ALL COLLECTION DAYS WILL REMAIN THE SAME

Accepted Recycle:

- Aluminum cans
- Plastic bottles (milk, water, detergent, shampoo)
- Glass bottles: clear, green, and brown
- Steel and tin cans
- Newspaper
- Mail
- Uncoated paperboard (cereal boxes, food boxes, snack boxes)
- Uncoated printing and office paper
- Uncoated corrugated cardboard

Nonrecyclables:

- Plastic bags
- Ceramics
- Light bulbs
- Soiled paper (pizza boxes, paper plates and cups)
- Metal and glass cookware
- Food waste
- Coated cardboard
- Napkins, paper towels, paper plates, and plastic utensils
- **NO YARD WASTE**



DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS!

Plastic bags will cause **CONTAMINATION** of the City's material and may result in **REJECTION** at the Recycling Facility.

COLLECTION OF BULKY/BRUSH ITEMS

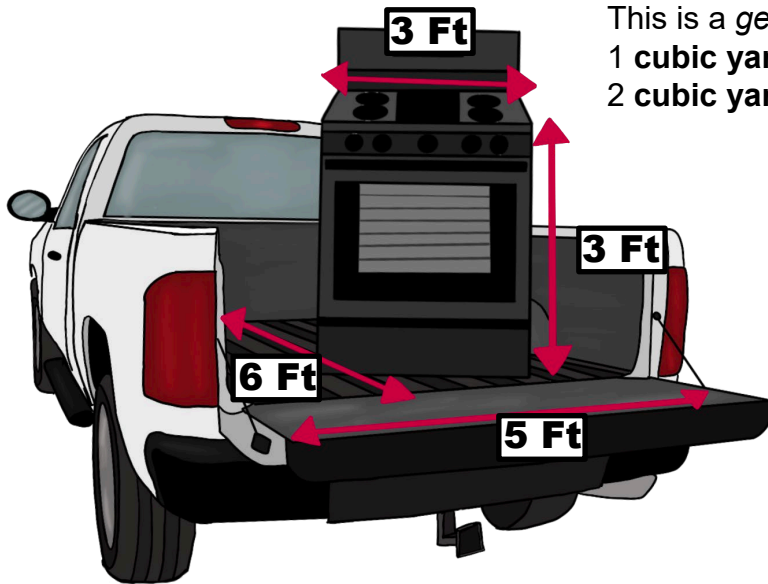
A combined 3 cubic yards of bulk/brush will be collected **ONCE** per week on your designated collection day.

Refer to the QR code, on the front page or the attached map, for your scheduled day.

BULKY WASTE / BUNDLED ITEM COLLECTION GUIDELINES:

- * Weight of Bulky Items: Individual Bulky items must light enough to be loaded into refuse vehicle by one person.
- * Residents are allowed to set out for collection - **3 yards** of BULKY WASTE & BRUSH per week (refer to diagram of cubic yards below)
- * Residents can set out acceptable BULKY items that are no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet by 4 feet
- * Please place smaller items in a container or box suitable for lifting items into refuse vehicle
- * Please bundle items such as newspapers, old rugs or small sections of carpet, small limbs
- * Please tie and bundle brush into 4-foot-long bundles. This is to be included in your 3-yard limit.

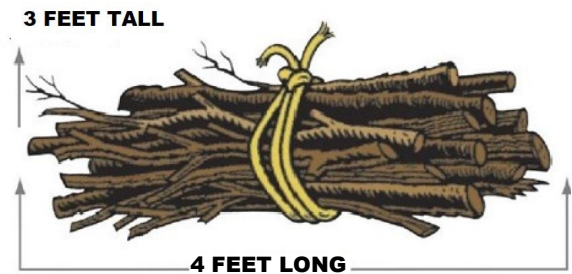
BAGGED YARD WASTE (leaves/grass) may be placed in your cart on your scheduled pickup day with the lid closed. **NO BLACK BAGS.**
Please only use paper lawn/leaf bags or clear plastic bags.



This is a *general guideline* for determining *bulk sizing*.

1 **cubic yard** is equivalent to the size of a **stove**.

2 **cubic yards** is equivalent to the size of a **standard truck bed**.



Maximum Width: 4 Feet
Maximum Weight: 40 Lbs
Maximum Diameter of Branch:

ACCEPTABLE BULKY ITEMS INCLUDE:

- * Furniture such as tables, sofas, chairs, lawn furniture
- * Appliances such as washing machines, dryers, stoves, water heaters, etc..
- * Misc. items including TV's, large toys, basketball goals, sports equipment, bikes, kid's toys must be labeled "bulky item" so they are not mistakenly put into trash truck.
- * Refrigerators/Freezers/AC Units: **IMPORTANT: Items MUST be tagged with proof of freon removal by certified technician in order to collect**

BULKY ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

- * No construction materials from remodeling projects—must call Frontier to get a quote on roll off container or special pickup
- * No dirt, bricks, rock, concrete, sand, or shingles
- * No stumps or tree limbs larger than 4 inches in diameter – must be split into 4-inch diameter.
- * Large limbs (larger than one person to handle)
- * No batteries, tires, pressurized tanks (ex: propane, helium, oxygen, acetylene)
- * No oils of any kind, gas/diesel/fuel, paint, chemicals, solvents, other hazardous materials, etc..

UNUSUAL ACCUMULATIONS OF BULKY WASTE / REMODELING / CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS /

RESIDENT MOVEOUT DEBRIS / BRUSH: If you have a large amount of bulk waste, brush, or construction materials from a project, please contact FRONTIER WASTE to receive an estimate for delivery of a construction dumpster to accommodate your project.
